## Summary

The Agenda Work Group discussed potential items for the March and April Meetings. The following items were agreed upon for March:

- Project update (with a focus on waste management)
- WIR Determination – overview and discussion of potential precedent for future waste determinations
- Asset Revitalization Initiative – examples of successful sites, discussion of interest and role of CTF and the wider community in building support and partnerships to advocate for the site and identify possible next steps
- Budget and EM Priorities presentation and discussion
- Proposed Backshift Monitoring Plan
- Review of 2011 CTF activities
