Dear Mr. Smith:

I wanted to take the opportunity to personally follow up with you from our October 23, 2006 telephone call and a Department of Energy (DOE) October 19, 2006 letter inviting NYSERDA to participate in a Core Team process to resolve issues of mutual interest regarding cleanup of the West Valley site. As I indicated earlier, we are prepared to break out the evaluation of technical alternatives from the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) process, and resolve the technical approach. Further, we believe we can do this within about one year, and at that point, we would rejoin the EIS process. More importantly, I commit that DOE will not unilaterally decide to remove the tanks without such a technical evaluation, and at the end of the process, we will make the decision that the technical evaluation supports.
