

RESOLUTION: Town of Concord Requests Federal Funding for West Valley
Demonstration Project not be cut

WHEREAS; the proposed 2007 – 2008 federal budget for the continued cleanup of the West Valley Demonstration Project site has been significantly reduced from the current federal fiscal year funding, and

WHEREAS; these proposed budget cuts will slow down the clean up project, increase future costs, effect local economy and increase the potential risk to the health and safety of the surrounding communities, and

THEREFORE; the Town Board of the Town of Concord agrees that the Federal Government must continue to provide adequate levels of funding to ensure that the clean up process is not prolonged, now therefore, be it

RESOLVED; that the Town Board of the Town of Concord supports all Federal, State, and County elected officials in the effort they must make to restore the budget funds for this project, and

RESOLVED; that the Town Board of the Town of Concord requests that the restoration of funds be made to continue cleanup and maintain the health, safety, and future of our Town and local residents.
