I hereby certify that a meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Concord held at the Town Hall in the Town of Concord on the 10th Day of April 2008, a resolution was adopted of which the following is a true copy:

Councilman Snyder presented and moved the adoption of Resolution 5, seconded by Councilman Salzler:

WHEREAS, The West Valley Demonstration Project is charged with the task of decontaminating and decommissioning the facilities, equipment, and materials used in the project in a manner that protects public hearing and safety, and

WHEREAS, Through this process an environmental monitoring program has been established to ensure that, among other things, public health and safety continues to be protected from potential releases of radioactive material from the project site, and

WHEREAS, Two established air sampling sites, AFSPRVL-near Rt 240 and Rt 39 in Springville, and AFWEVAL-near Rt 240 in West Valley, were strategically placed and have been in service for years are being removed by West Valley Environmental Services

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT

RESOLVED, That the Town Board of the Town of Concord, understands that there have been no recorded dangerous levels of airborne radioactive waste at these sites, but believes that these sites provide peace of mind for local citizens in regards to a potential release of airborne radioactive material from the site, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Town Board of the Town of Concord, in the name of public health and safety, encourages West Valley Environmental Services to leave these two air monitoring stations in place and continue to monitor the air pathways at these locations.
